1st stop, LAST stop, MEMS for Emergency Power

MEMS provided emergency power to New Spitalfields Market following an HV cable fault at the site. With power down at the purpose built 31 acre site in Leyton, East London, immediate power was required. However, Sid Brewer from the City of London Corporation was only able to find supply for the next day until he rang MEMS 24hr generator line on Saturday at 20.30hrs. MEMS arrived on site within 90 minutes of receiving the call.

On site MEMS advised that 3 LV switch boards required power with independent generators to be connected to each. MEMS guaranteed the client that 3 generators would be delivered and installed by 03.00hrs on Sunday to ensure power supply at the commencement of trading the following morning. This was to include the delivery of all cable and bulk fuel tanks until mains power was restored. Before the generator installation was able to proceed MEMS engineers were required to isolate the switch boards to remove incoming feeds from the sub stations which were subsequently replaced with MEMS generator cables.
